28	EMILY	Henry Chillingsworth	n! Little early for shave ice, ya?
29	HENRY	Emily Ho! It's never	too early for a shave ice.
30	EMILY	So what flavah you g	et?

- 1 HENRY Nothing better than Lilikoi...
- 2 EMILY No! Get ice cream on da bottom?
- 3 HENRY (SMILING) Is there any other way?
- 4 EMILY Uh-huh. One Snowcap.
- 5 HENRY How's that again?
- 6 EMILY Cream drizzled on top, making it look like Mauna Kea.
- 7 HENRY Next time, for sure. Emily, what's your favorite flavor? I'll buy you one.
- 8 EMILY (HEARTFELT) Lychee—a little bit of Heaven.
- 9 HENRY Here you go
- 10 EMILY Hmmm...Mahalo. So, what chu doing down here in Waikiki?
- 11 HENRY Trying to stay out of the heat at the Police Station. Here, you need a napkin.
- 12 EMILY (TEASING) Too much Kona winds for haoles?
- HENRY (DISGUSTED) No, that's not it. Big Eddie and his gang are really upset with
- 14 me.
- 15 EMILY Hah! Beeg Eddie always upset 'bout somtin'.
- 16 HENRY(SHUDDER) Not like this!
- 17 EMILY Why you worried?
- 18 HENRY Emily—if you worked for something other than the newspaper I'd be willing to
- 19 tell you.
- 20 EMILY I don't print everything I hea.
- 21 HENRY (DERISION) No? Just anything having to with CHANG.
- EMILY Is dat a problem?
- HENRY Everyone thinks we're joined at the hip! He's always wandering around and
- 24 getting me into trouble. I spend most of my free time trying to smooth the
- 25 waves he leaves in his wake as he twinkle-toes along.
- 26 EMILY So where's Chinatown's hero today?
- 27 HENRY I sent him down to the docks. I'm hoping that keeps him out of trouble and out
- of Big Eddie's hair. (THROATILY) And gives me some time to myself.
- 29 EMILY Do you think that's WISE?
- 30 HENRY Foolhardy. Chang's just like a little kid—you can't leave him alone for a
- 31 minute. You turn around and bam! Another screw up.

1 **EMILY** Have you heard anything about the big guy yet? 2 **HENRY** Big Eddie? (REMINDING) That's why I'm down here, Emily. 3 **EMILY** No, silly. Santy Claus. Emily Ho—you're telling me you believe in Santa Claus? 4 HENRY 5 **EMILY** What's a girl to think when the Islands are filled with reported sightings of a 6 Hawaiian-sized Haole around this time of year? Ho-ho-hoing. 7 **HENRY** I haven't heard a thing. Must just be a tourist. 8 **EMILY** But no one sees how he gets hea. We know he don't come in by steamship. He 9 just show up, soak up some of our sunshine, surf a little, and disappea just 10 before Christmas Eve. 11 HENRY Never heard of him. Gotta be a tourist. 12 Tourist or not, I'd love to get an interview with him. (TEASES) Maybe you **EMILY** 13 could put Chang Apana on him. 14 HENRY Now that's an idea. That'd keep him out of trouble. Chasing a will o' the wisp. 15 Just the thing. Thanks, Emily. 16 **EMILY** And eef he catchum, I get one interview? 17 We'll have to see—no promises. HENRY 18 **MUSIC** 19 (SCENE 2 At Lucy's house: Lucy and Chang) 20 ANNCR At the Ol' Plantation, home of Victoria Ward and Lucy, one of her six 21 daughters, a very wet Chang Apana is drying out. 22 LUCY I've sent for some lemonade, Chang. 23 CHANG T'anks, Miss Lucy. 24 LUCY What in the world were you doing swimming in your clothes? And very odd 25 clothes to see on you, I might add. 26 CHANG Was on docks as Kana Pung. Look for smuggling. 27 LUCY And it got too hot, so you fell in? 28 CHANG Not true. 29 LUCY What were you doing? You can tell me. 30 CHANG (RESISTING) Police stuff.

- 30 ANNCR The secretary of the Humane Society of Hawaii, Florence Marguerite Gurrey, is
- 31 having an afternoon tea with one of her closest friends, Helen Kinau Wilder.

1 FLO Helen, I suppose we have to ride in this travesty of a Christmas parade. 2 HELEN The Humane Society should have a presence there. 3 FLO (SLIGHTLY JOKING) I know! We could show off a few of those broken-down dray horses from Manoa Quarry—parade them right down the street. With 4 5 fancy bows on! 6 We wouldn't be allowed to do that! I'm afraid it would outrage people against HELEN 7 the Human Society. **FLO** 8 What, making a purse out of a sow's ear? 9 **HELEN** Sometimes out of sight has advantages of being out of mind. 10 FLO But it would really spice up the parade! All the haughty stares... 11 HELEN Flo, you sound bored with the parade. 12 I've ridden in it for years. It's just disgusting. FLO 13 HELEN Disgusting? It's basically the white oligarchy applauding themselves for taking Hawaii 14 FLO 15 away from the Hawaiians. 16 HELEN (LAUGHING) White Oligarchy? Those the kind of words they taught you at 17 that school on the Mainland? 18 FLO You mean my conscience is showing? 19 You came back with blood in your eye and lobbied for the job of secretary. HELEN Can't we do something to twist everyone's tails in this parade. 20 FLO (DESPARATE) 21 Something different? 22 HELEN What about something comical? Clowns, or... 23 FLO How can you be comical when you're sitting on a horse? 24 **HELEN** Okay, you don't like that idea. Let's think about elegant. 25 FLO Elegant like what? 26 HELEN Well...how about the group of us from the Society dress up as Pa'u riders? 27 Each horse and rider could be dressed up as a different island. 28 FLO You mean different colors for the Pa'u? Are you sure the horses would be okay 29 with all that fabric draped all over them? Nine yards of it?

1	HELEN	We can drape the fabric over the saddle, and have half of it on either side of the
2		horse. The ancient Hawaiians used them to cover the women's lower parts for
3		decency.
4	FLO	Since women didn't ride side-saddle back then, you mean?
5	HELEN	Yes. If we do it just right, the horses won't mind.
6	FLO	Pooling around the horse's feet, getting walked on and tripped on with each
7		step
8	HELEN	You're telling me that your horse isn't trained enough to handle it? I always
9		thought you were a better rider than that.
10	FLO (FIR	E) There isn't a horse on this island I can't ride.
11	HELEN	And we could have huge leis made of flowers around their necks! That would
12		look so grand!
13	FLO	That might brighten things up, Helen, but I don't see that it's going to liven
14		them up. I want to twist some tail!
15	HELEN (I	N DERISION) What do you want us to do—bring in Santa Claus?
16	FLO	Santa Claus? (CHANGE OF VOICE AS THINKING) Santa
17		Claus(ANOTHER CHANGE—ACCEPTANCE & ENTHUSIASM)
18		Santa Claus! I like it!
19	HELEN	You do? Florence, I was just joking!
20	FLO	No, think about it. It'll poke a big hole in everyone's high and mighty parade.
21		We'll be laughing at our "betters." And they won't be able to say anything
22		about. They can't throw rocks at Santa Claus! It's their heritage!
23	HELEN	We'll be the laughing stock of Honolulu.
24	FLO (LOV	W SADNESS) At least if they are laughing at us, they'll give Queen
25		Lili'uokalani a rest.
26	HELEN	Speaking about the Queen, do you want me to let Lucy know?
27	FLO	No, I'll do it, but not today. Don't let her hear you calling her that!
28	HELEN	I was just joking. What's happening today?
29	FLO	On Mondays, the real Queen has luncheon with Victoria Ward and the family.
30		Lucy will be involved with that. I don't speak good enough Hawaiian to attend.
31	HELEN	Surely they speak English.

1	FLO	Not since Queen Lili'uokalani was deposed by "her friends". Ever since then,
2		Mrs. Ward insists on only speaking Hawaiian, particularly when the Queen
3		visits.
4	HELEN (THINKING OUTLOUD) Maybe having Santa in the parade will do
5		something else, Florence.
6	FLO	Like what?
7	HELEN (WARMING MORE TO THE ARGUMENT) What kid—white, brown, yellow or
8		black, can resist Santa Claus? Could we turn the parade into something that
9		everyone living in the islands will enjoy watching?
10	FLO	You mean subvert it from being a parade about haoles patting themselves on
11		the back?
12	HELEN	If we talked about Santa being in the parade, I bet every kid in town will be on
13		the parade route, just to see.
14	FLO (DE	LIGHTED) Ha! The good ol' boys will hate it, having all those kids
15		underfoot. And their constant noise. Helen, HelenI love it!
16	HELEN	To get it in the papers, and encourage everyone to come, we could claim
17		sightings of Santa all over the island. Plant pieces in the newspapers
18	FLO	But Helen! Do you have someone in mind or are you just talking through your
19		hat?
20	HELEN	God will provide, I'm sure of it. But to be on the safe side, we need to get Lucy
21		involved. That girl gets the most amazing things done.
22	FLO	She should. She takes lessons.

25	ANNCR	Out at the Wilder Ranch several days later, Helen and Lucy Ward, longtime
26		friends and rebellious to the hilt plot their next thrust.
27	LUCY	Helen! It's working! It's really working!
28	HELEN	Do you really think we'll get away with this?
29	LUCY	Of course.
30	SFX	KNOCK
31	LUCY	Oh, that must be Big Eddie and Moki.

1	HELEN (AGHAST) Big Eddiethe gangster? You invited him here? Lucy, how
2		could you!
3	LUCY	No one will know. Who would suspect that Big Eddie was in cohoots with one
4		of the Island's Wilders.
5	HELEN	I certainly wouldn't.
6	SFX	DOOR OPEN, 2 pair FOOTSTEPS
7	BIG E	You want see me, ma'am?
8	LUCY (II	RONIC, BUT FIRM) Yes, she did.
9	HELEN	(STUNNED) Thanks for coming Biger Mr. Eddie.
10	BIG E	Oh, call me Beeg Eddie. Everyone does.
11	HELEN	Pleasehave a seat, sir.
12	LUCY	You too Moki. Please sit down.
13	BIG E	T'ank you, ma'am.
14	MOKI	T'anks.
15	HELEN	Lucy and I have a proposition for you, sir.
16	BIG E (S	MILE) Dis kinda sudden, ladies. Customary for exchange vows first.
17	LUCY (L	AUGHING) Got you there, Helen! Oh, stop blushing, we're not suggesting
18		<u>that</u> .
19	BIG E (Jo	OKING) Too bad. What chou have in mind?
20	LUCY	It occurs to me that one reason you're such a target for the police.
21	BIG E (M	IUTTERING) Some of dem.
22	LUCY (C	CON'T) is that you don't do anything to offset your well-known reputation.
23		What if you did something that make people think highly of you?
24	BIG E (M	IOCK CONCERN) And ruin my reputation? Ladies, dat's all I got!
25	LUCY/H	ELEN (BOTH GIGGLE)
26	HELEN	We've got something that might make you look good.
27	LUCY	Really good. And cover your other activities at the same time.
28	BIG E	You two wahine goan tell me mah business? 'Kay, tell me moa.
29	HELEN	The Christmas parade is coming up. It's usually so staid and awful. All my
30		relatives in their coaches, moseying along. But what if Santa Claus was in the
31		parade?

1	BIG E	Ladies, sorry but I heard dat Santa Claus myth. Besides he lives somewhere
2		north of North Beach. North Pole maybe.
3	LUCY	But he could come here on a vacation, couldn't he? Be in the parade and then
4		leave on his deliveries?
5	BIG E	Silly have beeg Haole inna red velvet suit, wid sleigh and reindeers! 80 degrees
6		outside, ya, and Kona weather to boot.

10	SFX	FISTFIGHT, THEN SPLASH AS CHANG GOES OVERBOARD.
11		SPLASHING SHOULD CONTINUE UNDER
12	LARSON	You try to come back into this canoe, I'll use my paddle on your head.
13	CHANG	(WETLY) (EFFORT TO CLIMB BACK IN.) You(SFX PADDLE THUD)

15	LARSON	Arrest? For what? Get off my canoe!
16	CHANG	Try hit me again, I grab paddle! Pull you in!

24	SFX	SPLASHING ENDS

26	(SCENE 7 WA	ARD'S GARDEN; HENRY LUCY HELEN BIG EDDIE MOKI, CHANG)
27	ANNCR	Several days later, Henry joined Lucy and Helen in the lush tropical garden at
28		the Ward's Christmas party. It's the night before the big parade. But the group
29		is far from jovial.
30	SFX: FOC	OTSTEPS ON GRAVEL
31	LUCY	Helen, here comes Henry. Maybe he's got good news.

1 HELEN (HOPELESSLY) Henry, have you seen him? 2 Not a sign of him anywhere. HENRY 3 **HELEN** What are we going to do? We've done such a good job getting people worked up about this. How are we 4 LUCY 5 going to say it was a hoax? 6 SFX RATTLE OF BRUSH 7 MOKI (WHISPERING) Psst!! Miss Helen, Miss Lucy... 8 HENRY (SUSPICIOUS) Who's there? 9 BIG E Beeg Eddie. 10 MOKI and Moki. 11 What in thunder are you doing here? HENRY 12 LUCY My mother will have you flayed if she finds you! 13 BIG E (ANGRY) You Haoles no play fair. I go out on a limb, loan you one expensive 14 canoe, convince mah captain, and den dis happens! 15 HENRY What happens? 16 BIG E ALL your fault, Chillingsworth! 17 **HENRY** I didn't do anything! 18 BIG E Dat understatement of the year. 25	BIG E (JU	JMPING ON) I'll Beeg Eddie you! All over da garden!
26	HENRY	Wait just a minute. We gotta listen to what happened. Lucy, since it's been
27		your idea all along, you start.
28	LUCY	Not precisely. It was mostly Flo's. Chang, you know we've been working on
29		the parade for tomorrow.
30	CHANG	Hoh.
31	LUCY	We arranged to borrow a red canoe from Big Eddie.

- 1 CHANG (SMALL VOICE) Red...canoe....
- 2 HELEN And hired the captain of Big Eddie's ship to portray Santa Claus.
- 3 CHANG (SMALL VOICE) Santa...clo...
- 4 BIG E Captain Larson looks like da haoles' Santa Claus. And you pinched him!
- 5 CHANG He was smuggling. No duties on toys. No duties on canoe.
- 6 BIG E Those were gifts, not for sale.
- 7 CHANG I watch. I watch allatime. Suspicious. When he tch'rew me off canoe, I got
- 8 mad. Hauled his okole off to jail.
- 9 LUCY Didn't he tell you who he was?
- 10 CHANG Kept yellin' Santa Claus at me. No look like Portagee, but whaddo I know.
- 11 (SHRUG) All haoles look alike.
- HENRY Well, that does it for Captain Larson.
- 13 CHANG ID said Larson, but he kept yellin' Santa Claus. ID not match.
- 14 HENRY But where's that confounded canoe?
- 15 MOKI (SMALL VOICE) I find canoe. Police impound yard.
- 16 HENRY (IRONIC) Oh, fine. Okay, this is what we're going to do...
- 17 BIG E I kill him first.
- 18 HENRY I know you want to, in fact we all want to, but we've got work to do. Chang, I
- want you to go get that canoe and bring it to the parade area.
- 20 CHANG How I do that?
- 21 HENRY You better find a way. And I want it polished until it gleams. I want you to stay
- there and guard it with your life.
- 23 MOKI What there is of it left.
- 24 CHANG Hoh.
- 25 HENRY Big Eddie, you and Moki go get those presents ready for the parade. They'll
- need to be packed into the canoe. So they can be handed out during the parade.
- 27 BIG E My toys....I no want to...
- 28 HENRY I don't want to either, but none of us has a choice tonight. I'll get Captain
- Larson out of jail---somehow. Chang, you owe me good. Malasadas aren't
- going to be enough this time.
- 31 HELEN Bring the Captain to my house. Lucy and I will get him spruced up, and ready.

- 1 LUCY Say goodbye to the party, everyone. We've got to race the sunrise!
- 2 MUSIC
- 3 (SCENE 8 POLICE STATION HENRY, DANNY)
- 4 DANNY Henry! What you doin' here? I thought you at party with big shots.
- 5 HENRY I was. Until the rug was pulled out from underneath me.
- 6 DANNY (JABBING) Oh--Your girl friend not there?
- 7 HENRY How many times do I have to tell you that Emily Ho is NOT my girlfriend?
- 8 DANNY Uh-huh. What our dog-catcher do now?
- 9 HENRY (WITHOUT A HOPE) He arrested Santa Claus.
- DANNY Santa Claus? He not know dat not real person?
- 11 HENRY Oh, this one's real enough. And Big Eddie is very un-happy.
- DANNY (WORRIED) Beeg Eddie? (SURPRISED) He believes in Santa Claus?
- HENRY And what's more, Moki says we got 'im!
- DANNY Auwe! You pullin' mah leg! Whatchu mean, we got 'im?
- 15 HENRY Danny, don't tell me we don't have someone down in the cells. We better have
- someone down there.
- DANNY Oh, we got someone. Just that lolo guy.
- 18 HENRY (EDGEY) Crazy guy? What crazy guy?
- 19 DANNY The one who keeps screamin' he's (REALIZING) Santa....Claus...
- HENRY (RESIGNED) So we do have him. I was so hoping that wasn't going to be
- 21 true.
- DANNY (INCREDULOUS) He really is? But...I not know...
- 23 HENRY If you don't want Big Eddie to make life even more difficult, we gotta get him
- out of here and over to the Wilders.
- DANNY Oh, so they believe he's S...
- 26 HENRY And we have to make the paperwork look good. He's going to ride in their
- blasted parade. Come on, get out the keys.
- 28 SFX DRAWER OPEN, JAGGLE OF KEYS
- 29 DANNY (LAUGHTER) Beeg joke! Dogcatcher lock up Santa Claus.
- 30 HENRY (SOURLY) Ho---ho. Come on, hurry it up. I've got things to take care
- of tonight, what's left of it.

- 1 DANNY (GRIN) Dancin' wid Miss Emily, I bet!
- 2 HENRY I wish. Big Eddie isn't that light on my feet.
- 3 MUSIC
- 4 (SCENE 9: PARADE EMILY & HENRY, FLO & HELEN, LUCY & CHANG)
- 5 SFX PARADE NOISES
- 6 CAST AD LIBS CHEERS and "SANTA! Over here!" "Santa!"
- 7 EMILY So there is a real Santa! Hooray!
- 8 HENRY (EXHAUSTED) You don't know how close that was.
- 9 EMILY Henry, you look awful. Were you up all night partying?
- 10 HENRY Just about. But I don't think I'd call it partying. But, you know? Looking at all
- those shining eyes—I think it was worth it.
- 12 EMILY And presents! Maika'i! (excellent) Henry...about that interview you promised
- me with the Beeg man...
- HENRY Don't ask, Emily! As soon as the parade is over, Santa has to go off on his
- rounds. In fact, he can't wait to get out of this town. He's been here too long.
- 16 EMILY Rough time, in Honolulu? What, he find gravel in his sand?
- 17 HENRY Unexpected, I think you could say.
- SFX/AD LIB CROWD NOISE up and then under
- 19 SFX HORSE HOOFS UNDER HELEN AND FLO
- 20 FLO (GLOATING) Look at all those kids! This parade will never be the same again.
- 21 HELEN Like your parade now? Now that it stands for something better than your
- friends.
- FLO (PRICKED) Not my friends, Helen. Betrayers of the Queen. Don't tar me with the
- same brush.
- 25 HELEN Enough of that. Smile for the kiddies, you reprobate.
- 26 SFX/AD LIB CROWD NOISE Up and then fade.
- 27 CHANG Lucy, got for you.
- 28 LUCY Oh, Chang, you shouldn't. You have kids to give presents for...
- 29 CHANG Apology for makin' you worry. Open, open.
- 30 SFX PASSING OF A BOX, OPENING
- 31 LUCY Chang... They are breath-taking. So beautiful.

3	CHANG	From you, be special.
4	LUCY	Here.
5	SFX	PASSING OF A BOX,
