10	<b>EMILY</b>	Well, it certainly looks like it. But there wasn't any thing about it happening
11		And I would know.
12	HENRY	And you know everything in Chinatown?
13	<b>EMILY</b>	Hey, you know I work for the Star-Bulletin! Chinatown is my beat.
14	HENRY(SM	IILING) Well, it's not really a parade. It's da kine impromptu. Chang Apana
15		arrested all these people and he's marching them off to the station.
16	<b>EMILY</b>	Auwe! All of them?
17	HENRY (M	OCK SERIOUS) Would I lie to you? Not all, only forty of them
18	<b>EMILY</b>	So where'd the rest of them come from? There's a couple hundred here.
19	HENRY	Oh, I think they saw this parade and just wanted to join in.
20	<b>EMILY</b>	"Impromptu parade in Chinatown, courtesy of Chang Apana"—Can I quote
21		you?
22	HENRY	Did I say that?
23	<b>EMILY</b>	I can't wait to get it into da papa.
24	HENRY	But you'll miss out on the rest of the story unless you come with us to the
25		station. Come on, join the parade.
26	<b>EMILY</b>	You just want my company.
27	HENRY	Could be, could be.
28	SFX	WALKING, AS THEY JOIN THE CROWD
29	EMILY	You must have quite a sweet tooth!
30	HENRY	What?

1	EMILY	Your sweet tooth. You've got 2 full bags of malasadas there.
2	HENRY	Yes, I have to pay a debt.
3	EMILY	Can I have one?
4	HENRY	I don't suppose Chang will mind.
5	SFX	RUSTLE OF BAG, TAKING OUT DOUGHNUT
6	EMILY	Mahalo. (HAVING A GOOD TIME) This is just like a lion dance,
7		without the lion.
8	HENRY	Oh, there's a lion here. At least he's got the Heart of a lion.
9	MUSIC THEM	<u>IE</u>
10	ANNCR	American Radio Theater presents Heart of a Lion—episode 1. Based on the
11		life and work of Chang Apana, Honolulu Police Department. But the legend
12		didn't start there. It began long before that. Back in 1893, on the Island of
13		Oahu, in Hawaii.
14	MUSIC—THE	WHIP
15	ACT I scene 1:	•
16	LUCY	No, Helen, hold the whip like this!
17	HELEN (DISB	ELIEVING) Like a fly-fishing pole? Lucy, I'm not trying to catch someone
18		with it.
19	LUCY	But it works better that way.
20	HELEN	And this little tag-thing, this string, at the end of the whip?
21	LUCY	That's the cracker, girl! You got to have that if you want it to crack, like this
22	SFX	CRACK OF WHIP
23	HELEN	My mater and pater are making a lot of trouble about this.
24	LUCY	You mean you want to do what they tell you to? Who are you and what have
25		you done with my Helen?
26	HELEN (LAU	GHING) Luce! Okay, bring on the whip. But I'm not going to put on rawhide
27		trousers for you.
28	LUCY	No, they are too hot. I relish the looks I get when I stroll up in my white
29		shirt-front dress, and pull out the whip! I like that look of stunned human.
30	HELEN (LOW	WARNING VOICE) Lucyhe's here again.
31	LUCY	Who? Helen, keep your mind on the lesson, will you?

1	HELEN	I've notice him before.
2	LUCY	One of your admirers, you mean?
3	HELEN (OUTR	AGED) He's a Pake, for heaven's sake!
4	LUCY	You have something against the Chinese? Are you marrying one?
5	HELEN	Talking about frightening the home folks. No, my father hired him to look
6		after the horses for the family.
7	LUCY	For a Chinese, Helen, he's pretty unusual.
8	HELEN	He's about as short as most of them. And skinny as a rail. Is that what you
9		mean?
10	LUCY	Open your eyes, girl. He's Chinese and he's not wearing the queue.
11	HELEN	Oh, I see that. Now that is odd. Well, it's also unusual that he wants to be a
12		paniolo.
13	LUCY	A cowboy? Can he ride?
14	HELEN (IRRIT	ATED) Of course he can. My father wouldn't have hired him otherwise.
15		But I get the funniest feeling he's following me, every time I come out to
16		practice the whip.
17	LUCY	You don't think your father put him up to that?
18	SFX	MOOS, BRUSH RATTLING
19	HELEN (WOR	RIED) Lucy! That sounds like those cows coming this way. We gotta get out of
20		here.
21	LUCY (EXCITI	ED) There they are! It's too late to run. Pick up your whip and let's make
22		them avoid us. This'll be fun!!
23	HELEN (PANIO	CKED) Lucy I can't do it!
24	SFX	FOOTSTEPS RUNNING
25	CHANG	I help! First, I take whip
26	SFX	WHIP CRACKS, MOOS MOVING OFF, BRUSH RATTLING
27	LUCY	Whew! Thanks, Pake.
28	CHANG	Chang. Chang Apana.
29	HELEN	Apana? You're not Hawaiian.
30	CHANG	Was Ah Ping. Didn't want.
31	LUCY	I think that wasn't all you didn't want.

- 1 CHANG (AMUSED) Not understand.
- 2 LUCY Oh, yes, I think you do. You've got the shortest haircut I've seen.
- 3 CHANG (GRUNT) Hunh.
- 4 HELEN You've been following me. Why?
- 5 CHANG Whip.
- 6 LUCY Whip?
- 7 CHANG Miss Ward, you da best with whip. I want learn.
- 8 LUCY You don't care that you have to learn from two wahine?
- 9 CHANG Why should I? You da best.
- 10 HELEN (LAUGHING) Lucy, it looks like you've got an admirer! I bet he's only a couple of
- 11 years older than us.
- 12 LUCY (SOURLY) Wonderful. Just what I need.
- HELEN (LAUGHING) What have you got against Pakes?
- 14 LUCY Oh, phooey.
- 15 MUSIC BRIDGE
- 16 ACT 1 Scene 2 JS Walker, in charge of the Humane Society, Lucy, Helen
- 17 WALKER Miss Wilder, Miss Ward.
- 18 HELEN: Mr. Walker. Thank you for seeing us. Something's got to be done about
- these animals! You're the head of the Humane Society. It's up to us to do
- something about all these neglected cattle.
- 21 LUCY And to take legal action against those horse owners who beat them or...
- 22 HELEN Overload them or....
- 23 WALKER: Ladies, ladies. That's not our problem.
- 24 HELEN It's not? You think this is just a social club for certain people? We should
- lead the way to responsible actions for those animals who can't talk for
- themselves.
- 27 WALKER: Miss Wilder, it's not ladylike to carry on this way.
- 28 HELEN (OMINOUS) What way is that, Mr. Walker?
- 29 WALKER: Riding around without a side-saddle, or ..using that bull-whip. The things I
- hear about you two! I'd think your families would be ashamed.

1	HELEN (OMIN	OUS) You mean that since I do those things, I can't have responsible thoughts
2		or actions?
3	WALKER:	That's exactly what I mean.
4	HELEN	And what about rescuing dogs and cats abused by their owners?
5	LUCY	Or rescuing women from those dens of iniquity? (SARCASTIC) Just what
6		part of Humane do you <u>do</u> ?
7	WALKER(PUS	HED TO HIS LIMIT) All right, all right! You're so concerned about it, Miss
8		Wilder, that you've just been appointed as special constable. YOU do
9		something about it.
10	HELEN	Special constable
11	WALKER	Let the Police Department deal with you?
12	LUCY	The Police?
13	WALKER (REI	LISHING AND ANTICIPATING HER DISTASTE)  That's correct. Our
14		special constables are attached to the Police. And that means that if they need
15		you for a police action, <u>you</u> have to go.
16	HELEN	I didn't know about that.
17	WALKER (SM	UG, PRICK) Oh, I think there are a lot of things you don't know, Miss
18		Wilder.
19	HELEN (ACCU	You don't think I can do it, do you?
20	WALKER:	Frankly, no I don't, Miss Wilder. The first time you have to handle those
21		cattle, you horse will probably dump you on your oh-so-white bustle. And I
22		won't shed a tear.
23	LUCY	Helen, this is our chance to prove ourselves.

26	LUCY (LAUG	HING) Oh, Helen!
27	WALKER	That's not funny! And you'll get a paycheck from the Police Department.
28		What do you think your oh-so-high-and-mighty family will think about that!
29	HELEN	Our own paycheck. Oh, that sounds very interesting. Not having to ask a dime
30		from Father

3	LUCY	You can be constable—I'll help. Sounds better and better.

6	HELEN (SWEE	But that's how we get unruly cattle to behave.
7	LUCY (BLOOI	O IN HER EYE) And if some man objects, we can legally do something
8		about it.
9	WALKER (HO	RRIFIED) Ladies! Perhaps I should take it back!
10	SOUND EFFEC	CTS: GETTING UP , FOOTSTEPS,DOOR OPEN
11	LUCY	Mr. Walker, you appointed Helen as the first woman officer in the police
12		department. The least you can do is give her a year to prove herself.
13	WALKER:	Butbut
14	HELEN	Good-day, sir. Thank you for all your cooperation. I look forward to starting
15		on the job.
16	LUCY	Good bye.
17	WALKER (DA	ZZED, RELIEF) Goodday.
18	SFX	DOOR SHUT
19	WALKER (TO	HIMSELF) What have I done?
20	MUSIC (WEAR	$\underline{RY}$
21	SFX: WHIP BE	ING THROWN ON A TABLE, FOLLOWED BY HAT
22	HELEN	Oh, Lucy, it's been SIX months, and I'm so tired
23	LUCY	Poor thing.
24	HELEN	It's not your fault, Lucy. I think you're probably as tired as I am. There's just
25		so much to do. And there's only two of us.
26	LUCY	We really need some help, but it's a sure thing that Walker's not going to do
27		anything.
28	HELEN	You mean, other than fire me?
29	LUCY	No, no. We've got to do this ourselves.
30	HELEN	Who could we get to give us a hand? None of our crowd is going to be

interested in working for a living.

1	LCY	We've got our number-one candidate in our midst.
2	HELEN	Really? Who's that?
3	LUCY	Only "the winner of the title of Best rider of horses"
4	HELEN	Who? (DAWNING RECOGNITION) Oh, no.
5	LUCY	"Winner of the title of Best Cowboy among the"
6	HELEN	Chinese. Chang is Chinese, Lucy!
7	LUCY	So? What's that got to do with anything?
8	HELEN	There hasn't ever been a Chinese in the Honolulu police department.
9	LUCY	Until they made you a special constable, there wasn't ever a woman in the
10		police department.
11	HELEN	But, Lucy! You know that only the whites have any power in Hawaii.
12	LUCY	Think about all the run-ins we've had with Chinese who abuse their horses.
13		And how they pretend that they can't understand what we tell them. If we had
14		Chang to talk to them, they couldn't evade.
15	HELEN	Say, that's right. But Lucy, he can't read or write English.
16	LUCY (CHUC	KLING) Or Chinese. So? Most of the men in the police force are
17		Hawaiians. They can't read or write either.
18	HELEN	Well, how do they get their job done? What could we do?
19	LUCY (LIGHT	TBULB) I know—we can hire a transcriber to write up the reports. The
20		rest of the Poi Dogs must being doing that.
21	HELEN	Poi dogs?
22	LUCY	Oh, Helen. Are you behind the times. I've heard that the police are calling
23		themselves that. You know—PD.
24	HELEN	That's for Police department.
25	LUCY	Also stands for Poi Dogs.
26	HELEN	But that's what we've been calling the mutts we pick up.
27	LUCY (LAUG	HING) And you don't think that fits the police to a T?
28	HELEN (AMU	SED) Another thing. Chang's so short, and skinny. He's not big enough to
29		handle the problems.
30	LUCY	He's almost as tall as you are. Are you saying 5'3" is too short for anything?
31	HELEN	Well, no. I better not!

- 1 LUCY He's pretty tall on a horse.
- 2 HELEN (LAUGHING) He's even better with a whip than you are.
- 3 LUCY Helen! Them's fighting words!
- 4 HELEN I have to admit he doesn't know the meaning of the word quit...
- 5 LUCY Or when to back away...Just like a lion.
- 6 HELEN Like a lion? More like a bulldog. Okay, you've made your point. I'll go
- beard Walker in his den, and see if I can force the issue.

- 28 <u>MUSIC BRIDGE (HONKYTONK?)</u>
- 29 SCENE 4: Tearful mother begging Lucy to rescue her daughter from a gin-mill café.
- 30 MOTHER (CRYING) Miss Ward, you're my last hope.
- 31 LUCY Oh, Mrs. K. What's the matter? You look terrible.

1	MOTHER	That daughter of mine! She's gone down to Chinatown to be aafallen
2		woman!
3	LUCY	Surely that's an exaggeration. Pei has always been a good girl.
4	MOTHER	Until she started hanging around with that Eddie Mokulani. He's been
5		nothing but a horrible influence on her.
6	LUCY	Eddie Mokulani
7	MOTHER	He's one of that surfer crowd.
8	LUCY (REME	MBERING) Ah. I remember him now.
9	MOTHER	And he gambles, and drinks. Probably smokes opium for all I know.
10	LUCY	So what do you want me to do about it?
11	MOTHER	Go get her back. You rescue dogs, cats, horseswhy not children?
12	LUCY	(RESOLVED) All right. Where did she go, do you know?
13	MOTHER	Pantheon Bar.
14	LUCY	You come with me.
15	SFX WALKIN	NG DOWN TO THE CAFÉ, STREET NOISES
16	LUCY	Pantheon—the oldest bar in Honolulu. In we go.
17	SFX	OPENING DOOR (SWINGING DOORS?)
18	MOTHER	There she is! That back table. (GASP) And she's kissing him—in public!!!
19	SFX	FOOTSTEPS
20	LUCY	Pei! I've got a complaint to serve against you. You're coming with me.
21	PEI (INSOLEN	T) Go get on your horse, haole. I like it here.
22	MOTHER (SH	OCKED) Oh, Pei!
23	SFX	SCUFFLING, FOOTSTEPS
24	LUCY	(EFFORT) You'recomingwithmeif I have to drag you by the
25		hair!
26	PEI	Owwww!!!! Let go of meyou witch! Let go of me
27	LUCY	Lead the way out, Mrs. K.
28	EDDIE	Hey, that's my girl you're taking! Let her go!
29	PEI (SHRIEKI	NG) Eddie!!! Eddie!! Don't let them take me.
30	SAJ	Eddie, why are you getting so upset? She's just a wahine.
31	EDDIE	But she's my wahine. (CALLING) Pei! Pei!

1	SFX	SWINGING DOORS OPEN, FOOTSTEPS
2	EDDIE	I'll get her! No woman is going to rob me of my wahine!
3	SFX	CRACK OF WHIP
4	CHANG	I wouldn't recommend it, gentlemen.
5	EDDIE	I gotta get Pei back!
6	CHANG	I t'ink not!
7	SFX	WHIP, FOOTSTEPS
8	SAJ	Lordy, it's Chang Apana! I thought it was his day off!
9	LUCY	I didn't need your help, Chang. I can handle this on my own.
10	PEI (IN BACK	GROUND) Let go!! Stupid Maka'i! Let go!
11	CHANG: (AM	MUSED) Ahhhh, Miss Lucy! I know. I just practicing whip.
12	LUCY	What are you doing down here?
13	CHANG	Taking family for walk.
14	LUCY	1-2-34- keikis.
15	CHANG (PRO	UDLY) Another on the way.
16	LUCY	Five! You have been busy.
17	CHANG	Please excuse. Number one son!
18	NO 1 SON	Yeah, pops?
19	CHANG	Shung Chong Yuein Bakery. 5 pound flour.
20	No 1 Son	Sure, pops.
21	SFX	RUNNING FOOTSTEPS
22	LUCY	Having a special occasion?
23	CHANG	Having Heavenly Lemon cake for dessert.
24	LUCY	Your wife must be a wonderful baker.
25	CHANG (DISC	GUST) Huh!! Wife play mah-joong! I cook.
26	PEI (YELLING	G, SOBBING) Eddie! Eddie!
27	CHANG (OBS	ERVED) Girl too noisy.
28	LUCY	Pei, you get home this minute! Eddie, I'll run you in next, if you don't let her
29		go.
30	SFX	GIRL CRYING, WHIP CRACKING

1	CHANG	Aloha, Miss Lucy. Keikis! Gather around. Number one son, let that wahini
2		alone.
3	NO. 1 SON	Aw, Pop. I wasn't doing anything. Just lookin'.
4	CHANG	Keep eyes in own head.
5	NO.1 SON	But POP!
6	CHANG	Be good or Lucy Ward will get you! Now, we go home.
7	MUSIC PLAY	<u>OFF</u>
8	ANNCR	We'll return to Chinatown and Chang Apana Hear of a Lion. As a special
9		treat Papa Smurf and the Poi Dogs will entertain us with some Hawaiian
10		music.

12	ACT II	The Gambling Incident
13	ANNCR	We return to American Radio Theater's presentation of Chang Apana, Heart
14		of a Lion. There's a meeting going on in the Police Station, downtown
15		Honolulu. Chang sits against a wall, at the back, listening to the Police Chief
16		exhort his staff into action.
17	Scene 5	
18	CHIEF	The gambling being done in Chinatown is out of control. We've got to do
19		something about it.
20	DANNY	Gee. Chief. Are you up for re-election?
21	Cast: LAUGH	TER
22	CHIEF	(HIS FACE RED) Ofof course that's not the reason.
23	COP2	(KNOWINGLY) Ah, one of your Haole friends then.
24	CAST: smothe	red chuckles
25	COP 1	Danny, you betta stop else we gotta cell downstairs.
26	CAST: CATCA	ALLS
27	CHIEF	That's enough. No matter what the reason, the gambling in Chinatown has got
28		to stop.
29	DANNY:	Or at least arrest SOME ONE.
30	Cop 1	It's impossible, Chief! The gambling rooms are always on the second floor.

1 **HENRY** By the time I get through all four of those doors and guards to go with them, 2 nobody's gambling anymore. And they just sit there looking... inscrutable. 3 **CHIEF** We have got to have the money on the table! We have to swear we saw it! 4 DANNY: Or they walk all ova us, like they do allatime. 5 **HENRY** But Chief, it's always gone, by the time I get there! And I look absolutely 6 stupid. 7 Not hard. DANNY: 8 COP 1 (WARNING) Danny! Can you do betta? 9 DANNY: Maybeso. 10 **CHIEF** I'll adjust the schedule. 11 DANNY: Uh, let's not be in hurry here. 12 COP 1: It's impossible, Chief. It's flat-out impossible. You might as well make 13 gambling legal, for all that we're being able to control it. 14 CHANG: Not so. 15 COP 1 (SARCASTIC) Wait. Our dog and cat boy has something to say! 16 HENRY (EGGING HIM ON) Oh, come on. You think you can do any better? 17 **CHIEF** Hold on. Let's hear what Chang Apana has to say. 18 CHANG: Need to blend in. 19 COP 1 Oh, sure. We're in Chinatown, Chang. Blending in ain't all that easy. 20 **CHANG** Plenty haoles gamble. Plenty Kanakas. 21 **HENRY** I've tried that, Chang. 22 COP 1 And when I tried it, I didn't even get to the second floor. 23 CHANG Everyone know detectives. 24 **CHIEF** You have a better idea? **CHANG** 25 Maybeso. 26 SFX OPENING PAPER BAG. TAKING OUT CLOTHES. 27 COP 1 Why are you taking clothes out of that bag? 28 DANNY: You gonna dress up as what? A wahini? 29 **HENRY** Chang, EVERYBODY can spot you two streets away, even in Chinatown. 30 **CHANG** They recognize white suit and paniolo hat. If I wear coolie pants, coolie 31 jacket, coolie shoes, ...

1	COP 1	Do you really think that will work?
2	CHANG	Did work. Boro-boros clothes.
3	CHIEF	What worked?
4	CHANG (SMU	G) Unloaded cargo as Kana Pung on docks two days ago.
5	CHIEF	You're not working two jobs now, are you?
6	CHANG	No, no. Just hanging around docks, watching. Watching for opium.
7	HENRY	And you got hired, just like that?
8	COP 1	You know how they operate down there, Henry. A ship comes in, and they
9		grab anyone they can find to unload it. As long as they are breathing and have
10		two strong arms.
11	CHANG	Could work in Chinatown.
12	CHIEF	Chang, would you be willing to try it? If we sent you in before the raid?
13	CHANG	Would work inside building.
14	CHIEF	You'd be taking a big risk, Chang.
15	HENRY	Chief! He could be killed. There isn't a person in that place that isn't carrying
16		a weapon. Guns, knives, brass knuckles
