18	ROGER	If there was a medal for shopping, you're get the
19		gold.
20	EDNA	And you'd get the medal for not-shopping. It's just
21		amazing why guys always leave all the shopping to
22		their wives. Never a thought on their own.
23	ROGER	All this fuss about Black Friday. Stores opening at
24		3 AM or 4 AM.
25	EDNA	Why do you suppose it's called that?
26	ROGER	Well, not because everyone's bank account goes into
27		mourning, that's for sure.
28	EDNA	Oh, that'd be funny. Black crepe bordering all the
29		savings accounts, black paper rosettes at the banks'
30		ATM machines.
31	ROGER	Edna, it's because it's the first day that the
32		merchants finally achieve a profit for the year.

1	EDNA	So they immediately put everything on sale? Seems
2		kind of odd to me.
3	ROGER	They entice people in the store with loss leaders.
4	EDNA	How can leaders who are lost be of any help?
5		Honestly, Roger, the things you bring up.
6	ROGER	Edna! I mean that some things are sold at a loss.
7		That they cost more for the store to buy than they
8		get back when they sell it.
9	EDNA	How can anyone make a profit doing that?
10	ROGER	It has to do with volume of sales. If they get
11		people in to buy one thing, they'll buy others at
12		the same time.
13	EDNA	That's not bait and switch is it?
14	ROGER	No, that's when they advertise something but then
15		you can't find it at the store.
16	EDNA	Well, I only go after things that are on my list.
17	ROGER	Really? What about that porcelain elephant in the
18		hallway?
19	EDNA	Roger, that's different.
20	ROGER	Was it on your list that day?
21	EDNA	The book club was reading Kim-
22	ROGER	Kim? Wasn't that about a girl who eloped with
23	EDNA	No, Roger. It's the one written by Rudyard Kipling
24	ROGER	Kipling? Never heard of him.
25	EDNA	You've heard of him. You've heard of The Jungle Book
26		haven't you?
27	ROGER	Wasn't that a movie by Walt Disney? It had Eddie
28		Murphy in it?
29	EDNA	No, not Shrek-or maybe you're thinking of Mulan.
30		This one had somebody Harris in it.
31	ROGER	Oh, yeah! That "Bear necessity" guy. Stacy Harris.

- 1 EDNA No. It was Phil Harris. I bet you can't even 2 remember him. 3 ROGER Wasn't he the Tiger? He was just great. 4 EDNA Can I give you a clue? Bear necessities? 5 ROGER Sure he wasn't the Tiger? 6 EDNA George Sanders was the Tiger. The movie was from 7 1967. 8 ROGER Why did you bring that up? 9 Look, the author of The Jungle Book is the same one EDNA 10 who wrote Kim. His name was Rudyard Kipling. 11 ROGER I don't remember seeing that name on the credits as 12 the screenwriter. 13 Kipling wrote both BOOKS. Do you know how much that would cost? 25 There's poor people everywhere begging, and... 26 No, not India. Stay on the subject, Roger. I want to EDNA 27 go shopping tomorrow, on Black Friday. 28 ROGER (EVEN MORE AGHAST) At 3 AM? Are you crazy? 29 I hate shopping in crowds. It'll be an adventure. EDNA Getting up in the black of night, going off on 30 31 safari for the wild present...

1	ROGER	You couldn't pay me enough to get up at 3AM to go
2		shopping. No matter what kind of sale.
3	EDNA	Probably would be a good idea to skip the popular
4		stores like Walmart or Target. They might have a
5		little bit of a crowd.
6	ROGER	You could skip it all together, Edna. Is there
7		something on your list you've got to have?
8	EDNA	Oh, I have some ideas, but they're based on the ads
9		that you have been disparaging. Lots of families
10		make it a traditional outing. They even have their
11		stores mapped out as to where they want to go first,
12		and the big killing.
13	ROGER	Even worse, setting the alarm for 1 AM, to get to a
14		store by 3?
15	EDNA	Some people just stay up all night, having a party,
16		before going out on the hunt. They just don't go to
17		bed.
18	ROGER	Great. Fighting their way across crowded territory,
19		making decisions that will affect the rest of their
20		lives, without a modicum of adequate rest. Sounds
21		just like being in a war. Is that why you women are
22		so good at it?
23	EDNA	Shirley and Helen want to go too. They're going to
24		pick me up at 2:30.
25	ROGER	AM? When do you expect to get home?
26	EDNA	When we get home. We'll probably have breakfast out.
27	ROGER	What about my breakfast?
28	EDNA	Oh, you can handle breakfast on your own. There's
29		cereal under the counter and half and half in the
30		frig.
31	ROGER	You mean on my day off, I have to forage for myself?

Yes, just like in a war. Roger, I will make you some 1 EDNA 2 coffee before I leave. 3 ROGER But that will be hours before I get up. It'll be 4 stale. 5 EDNA You could come along and keep me company. 6 ROGER You're not getting me up at 2 AM for a hen party. 7 EDNA (WHEEDLING) You could drive. The Fisherman's Authority 8 is going to open at 4. 9 ROGER (INTERESTED) They are? 10 EDNA You could drop us off at Jacques Pennay's and be 11 back at Fisherman's Authority in time for its 12 opening at 4. 13 RUSTLE OF NEWSPAPER SFX 14 Do they have an ad in this paper someplace? ROGER 15 EDNA It's right here. 16 SFX TAPPING NEWSPAPER 17 ROGER (EXCITED) Wow! Look at all that stuff! 70 percent 18 off! I've got to get started. 19 EDNA Roger, they're not on sale until tomorrow morning. 20 ROGER I need to pack in some supplies for tonight's party. 21 EDNA Party? 22 ROGER I'll invite the guys over, and you call Shirley and 23 Helen. 24 **EDNA** Tonight? 25 ROGER I'm not getting up at 2 AM to go shopping, but 26 staying up all night sounds like it'd be great fun. 27 Let's see-I'll get some beer, and potato chips, and
