31	HART	The name is Hartley, Bodiddly.

1	SLEEPY	What did you just call me? Bo Diddly, huh?
2	HART	Cowboy, Ah don't know anyone here. The Sheriff said his name was Thom
3		Jeffers.
4	SLEEPY	Lovely Dove! He's the new Indian Agent. And you went and killed him.
5	HART	Ah DID NOT! Has he been in town long?
6	SLEEPY	Only a couple of months. I'll bet Sally's gonna be upset.
7	HART	Is that his wife or sweetheart?
8	SLEEPY	Why—are you plannin' on romancin' her?
9	HART	No, dim-wit. Ah just thought she might have an idear if someone in town had
10		it in fer Thom.

- 11SLEEPYOh, that's different. Their house is the last one down this street. We could stop12in and give our condolences to her.
- 13 HART You ain't told me yet if it's his wife.
- SLEEPY I haven't because it's not. She's his sister, and a purty little thing, too. Just a
 little too high falutin' for the like of me. This house, son.
- 16 SFX FOOTSTEPS STOP, KNOCK ON DOOR.
- 17 SALLY (MUFFLED) Who's there?
- 18 SLEEPY Hi Miss Sally. It's Sleepy Stevens. Can I talk with you?
- 19 <u>SFX</u> DOOR OPEN
- 20 SALLY (UPSET) Oh Sleepy! It's real nice of you to come by. Thom is...
- 21 SLEEPY (BREAKING IN) Yes, Ma'am, I know. I just heard about Thom. He was a
- 22 mighty fine man. A man we could all look up to...
- 23SALLYAnd he got murdered for it. I knew this was a mistake coming out here, but24Thom wanted to do something for the Indians. He wanted to right some of the
- 25 wrongs done to them. He felt he could do some good.
- 26 SLEEPY What are you gonna do now, Miss Sally?
- 27 SALLY I'd go back home on the quickest train, except...there's...
- 28 HART Except what, ma'am.
- 29 SALLY Oh, I'm sorry, I didn't see you standing there.
- 30 SLEEPY Where's my manners? Miss Sally, this is Hashknife.
- 31 HART (STRANGLED RESPONSE) Except what, Ma'am?

2	HART	Someone Thom didn't like?
3	SALLY	On the contrary, Thom thought the world of Frederick Tanner.
4	HART	FrederickFreddy Tanner? Is he mixed up in this?
5	SALLY	What do you mean, mixed up in this? Frederick is a wonderful man. He's
6		been selling cattle to Thom for the Indians at a decent reasonable price.
7	HART	Ah just bet he has.
8	SALLY	He's so kind and thoughtful. He's been so considerate.
9	HART	I'm sure he's everything you need him to be ma'am. Come on, Sleepy. Ah
10		gotta check something at the office. My condolences, ma'am.
11	SALLY	Thank you. II can't believe he's gone! (sob)
12	SFX	DOOR SHUT
13	SLEEPY	Good night, Miss Sally
14	SFX	FOOTSTEPS
15	SLEEPY	Where to now, Hashknife?
16	HART	Not Hashknife!
17	SLEEPY	Take it easy, cowboy. Nothing to get riled about. Unless you just like walkin'
18		around in the dark in a strange town.
19	HART	Ah want to check the records at the Indian Agency. Where is it?
20	SLEEPY	Oh, right down this alley. Why do you want to look at those? Ain't nothing
21		but a bunch of tally marks.
22	HART	Oh? You've seen 'em?
23	SLEEPY	Yeah, I seen 'em. I drove part of a herd over there last week. Funny thing
24		about that though, come to think of it.
25	HART	What's that?
26	SLEEPY	There was a cow that I coulda sworn I've had in another bunch that I took to
27		the same place. But that don't make no sense.
28	HART	After a while, all cows look alike.
29	SLEEPY	Particularly if they is just tallymarks on a ledger. But there was this one cow
30		with a busted-off horn

2	SFX	RUMMING IN DRAWERS, FLIPPING OPEN LEDGERS, PAGES
3	HART	Uh-huhNow that's real interestin'.
4	SLEEPY	What is, son?
5	HART	Oh, these tallymarks
6	SLEEPY	I told you! What's it take to get you to believe me.
7	HART	But cowboythey don't tally.
8	SLEEPY	Huh? What do you mean? Of course they tally. I drove those danged cows
9		myself.
10	HART	The amount paid out for a certain number of cows doesn't tally with the
11		number of cows given to the Indians.
12	SLEEPY	How could that be? Thom was as honest as the day is long.
13	HART	He's only been here for what—a couple of months?
14	SLEEPY	Yeah.
15	HART	This goes back a lot farther than that.
16	SLEEPY	It does?
17	HART	And if I know Freddy Tanner, he's got his hand in it all the way up to his

- 28 in the Civil War. John reports that the Indians aren't getting much in the way of cattle, just
- 29 one or two. Bob Marsh thought something was amiss, and sent Hartley into the area.

- 1 SLEEPY Hashknife, where we goin' now?
- 2 HART Stop callin' me that!
- 3 SLEEPY Cain't help it. You just look like a hashknife.
- 4 HART Sharp and pointy, huh? You know where abouts the Indians' reservation is?
- 5 SLEEPY Why shore. You cain't walk there though. You gotta have a horse.
- 6 HART Sleepy, how do yuh think Ah got into town?
- 7 SLEEPY Well, yeah. But there's other ways, ya know.
- 8 HART Ah'd be a poor cowboy without my horse and saddle, wouldn't Ah? My horse
 9 is probably still over at the saloon.
- 10 SLEEPY Drinkin' it up, no doubt.
- 11 HART He got more of a drink than Ah got that's for shore.
- SLEEPY My Appalatchy is over in the stable at the edge of town. Leastways that's
 where Dusty told me he'd put her.

- 15 SLEEPY We're real close now. This is where we usually drop off the cattle for them.

- 1 HART Ah want to see this Indian encampment. And the cattle didn't go that way.
- 2 SLEEPY Thunderation. How could you tell?
- HART Sleepy, there's a full moon tonight. The cattle leave a trail that a blind man
 could see.
- 5 MUSIC TO DOGS BARKING, CHILDREN PLAYING.
- 6 LITTLE WOLF Stop, white man. What business here?
- 7 <u>SFX</u> HORSES PAUSE, SNORT
- 8 SLEEPY Lovely Dove. Ain't sure it's a welcomin' committee or what.
- 9 HART Is that you Little Wolf? You're sure talkin' funny, John.
- 10 SLEEPY (SHOCK) Little Wolf? You cain't mean to say you know this injun!
- 11 LITTLE WOLF I know you, white man?
- 12 HART It's been some time. Lemme take off mah hat.
- 13 LITTLE WOLF (RECOGNITION DAWNS) Lenny? Is that really you?
- 14 HART Cain't tell without mah beard, huh?
- 15 LITTLE WOLF When I sent you that letter, I never really expected you might come.
- 16 HART (SMILE) Where's yore faith, Little Wolf? The sky god provides, don't
- 17 he?
- 18 SLEEPY (IRRITATED) Some one tell me what's goin' on!

- 20 HART Seems to be called Sleepy Stevens. (con't)

20		met the man, and here Ah'm blamed for killin' 'im.
21	CHIEF	You think it's mixed up with this cattle business?
22	HART	Shore looks like it to me.
23	CHIEF	Not that anyone will pay attention. Just one man's word against the Indians.
24	HART	Little Wolf, you wrote that you been keepin' track of how many cattle.
25	LITTLE WOI	LF That's why I know there's something going on.
26	HART	Bring out those ledgers, Sleepy.
27	SLEEPY	(HORROR) You're gonna give 'em to the Injins? Hashknife, you'll be
28		strung up for sure!
29	LITTLE WOI	LF Lenny, what's all this Hashknife business?
30	HART	Ah don't wanna talk about it. But if you start callin' me that, Little Wolf, there
31		might be murder in my eye yet.

1 LITTLE WOLF (GRIN, DELIGHTED) Don't like it much, huh? 2 HART Sleepy, see what you started! 3 SLEEPY (INNOCENT) Started what, son? 4 Little Wolf, compare your figures with the tallys in these ledgers. That might HART 5 give you some ammo. 6 CHIEF Good. 7 HART With Thom Jeffers dead, who is the Indian Agent? 8 CHIEF Same as last year. 9 SLEEPY (PEEVED) Hashknife, I could told you that! The same hombre that hires me to 10 drive cattle—Frederick Tanner. 11 HART Freddy Tanner! Ah had a feelin' he'd turn up agin. No wonder those ledgers stink to me. Little Wolf-did you know? 12 CHIEF 13 Papers always signed by F. Tannenbaum. 14 LITTLE WOLF You're telling me that Tannenbaum is actually Freddy Tanner? I had 15 no reason to suspect that Tanner might have his fingers in this business. HART 16 You never saw him out here? 17 LITTLE WOLF Since when do the Indians ever see the Indian Agent? 18 SLEEPY(IRRITATED) Why is it everyone knows about Freddy Tanner but me? I'm 19 the only one who worked for 'im. In fact, I'm the only one that met the dude. 20 LITTLE WOLF (GRIM) If we are talking about the same man, he deserted from our 21 outfit in the War. 22 HART It was after he disappeared that we found that poor family tortured 23 and...murdered. 24 SLEEPY Maybe he didn't do it. 28	SLEEPY	You're not sa	fe to be let out on your own. You get into all sorts of trouble.
29	HART	Ah'm just fin	e on mah own.
30	SLEEPY	Yeah—you ha	ang around withwithIndians/
31	HART (SMII	LE) Ah tho	bught you called them Injins.

1	SLEEPY (AB	ASHED) That was afore I met some of 'em. That Lone Wolf talks
2		better'n me. Reads and writes like a dad-blamed lawyer.
3	HART	Cherokees aren't your garden variety Injin.

 - 9 HART (WHISPERING) Come on Sleepy. We gotta leave now.
- 10 SLEEPY But they were talking about me.
- 11 HART Come on!
- 12 SFX RUNNING ON WOOD AND THEN DIRT
- 13 CHARLES There they are!
- 14 FRED Open fire. Let's get 'em!
- 15 SFX REVOLVERS FIRING
- 16 HART (PAIN) Uhh. I caught one.
- 17 SLEEPY Hashknife! You're hurt!
- 18 HART Got toget to the...horses...
- 19 SLEEPY We're here. Get up. (STRUGGLE)
- 20 SFX HORSES NEIGHING, SADDLE CREAKING
- 21 SLEEPY Ride! Get up! Hahhh! Hahhhh!
- 22 <u>SFX HOOF BEATS.</u>
- 23 MUSIC TO HOOFBEATS SLOWING, THEN BODY FALL
- 24
- 25 SLEEPY Lovely dove! Hashknife! Whoa! Whoa!
- 26 SFX HOOFS STOP, HORSES BLOW, CREAK OF SADDLE
- 27 SLEEPY You didn't tell me you were going to fall off!
- 28 HART (in PAIN) Sorry, pardner. (GROAN)
- 29 SLEEPY Where are you hurt?
- 30 HART (PAIN) Mah...mah leg.
- 31 SLEEPY Oh, Lord, look at all that blood. What am I goin' to do with you?

- 1 HART Ah've got a kind of clean shirt in mah saddlebag...
- 2 SLEEPY You weren't supposed to get shot!
- 3 SFX RUMMAGE IN SADDLE BAG
- 4 SLEEPY (DISTRACTED) Was it worth it?
- 5 HART Was what worth...
- 6 SLEEPY What we heard. Was it worth getting shot?
- 7 HART Yeah...maybe...Ah think...(PASSES OUT)
- 8 SLEEPY Hashknife! Hashknife! Hash...Lenny! Lovely dove. Come on, soldier. Back
 9 in the saddle. I'm taking you to Sally's.
- 10 MUSIC
- 11 [SCENE 5 SALLYS]
- 12 SFX HEAVY FOOTSTEPS
- 13 SLEEPY I'm sorry, Miss Sally, but I didn't know where else to go.
- 14 SALLY You could have tried the jail. Here, put him there on the settee.
- 15 SLEEPY (EFFORT)
- 16 SFX PUTTING HIM DOWN
- SLEEPY Come on—he sprung me, I couldn't take him back. Whooo-eee, you really
 know your way around a wound.
- 19 SALLY I had too much practice in the war.
- 20 SFX RIPPING CLOTH
- 21 SALLY There, I think that will hold him.
- 22 FRED (OFF) Sally? Are you decent? I need to talk to you. I'm coming in.
- 23 SLEEPY (WHISPERS) No, don't let him in!
- 24 SALLY No, don't come in. I'm not ready.
- 25 FRED (OFF) Why? Are you having special company?
- 26 SFX DOOR BANGED OPEN, BOOTS
- 27 CHARLES Yeah, he's here. Son, you left a trail of blood all the way here. And lookee
 28 here, it's Sleepy Stevens. By golly, two birds in one shot. A jack pot.
- 29 (SERIOUS) Put your hands up.
- 30 SALLY Frederick! I'm so glad you came. I wasn't sure what else to do.

1	CHARLES	I'll tell what we're going to do-we're going to get rid of these two polecats!	
2		They trespassed on Frederick's property and then had the gall to evesdrop in	
3		a private conversation.	
4	SALLY	Frederick, what's wrong? You look so strange, darling.	
5	FRED	It can't be! It can't be	
6	HART (PAIN	Why? This is exactly how you left me before, Freddy.	
7	FRED	You're that cowboy!	
8	HART	Yeah, the one you framed for Jeffers' murder. Wrong, wrong, wrong. Ah use	
9		a gun, not a knife, when Ah have to.	
10	SALLY	Thom's murder? How can that be? You said he was	
11	FRED	Darling—dearest. Please, please just be quiet. This is man talk. Cowboy, you	
12		remind me of someone	
13	HART	Unfortunately Ah know exactly who you are. You almost succeeded that day,	
14		Tanner. You went from torturing and killing that poor Harrisson family, to	
15		makin' sure all your grievances against me were settled. Ah was the only	
16		person in camp that afternoon.	
17	FRED (AGH	AST) Harrisson family?	
18	SALLY (SOFT ECHO) Harrisson family		
19	HART	But you missed your chance. Little Wolf came back into camp before you	
20		could finish me.	
21	FRED	Didn't succeed, huh? Looks like I got a second chance!	
22	SALLY (SUSPICION) What Harrisson family?		
23	FRED	Darling, it wouldn't mean anything to you.	
24	HART	It was years ago, Sally. In the war.	
25	FRED	Yeah, and you lost it.	
26	HART	Lee surrendered, that was true. But most of us didn't lose ourselves. Freddie,	
27		you were part of mah company, but you cut and run—run out on men who	
28		trusted you.	
29	SALLY (URGENT) Where was this? Where?		
30	HART	You don't even remember, do you, Freddie? Too many others, Ah guess.	
31		Remember that little house down in that peaceful little valley.	

1	FRED	What are you talking about?
2	HART	Sleepy, he's not helping.
3	SLEEPY	Danged if I know anything about this!
4	HART	By the crick in the southern part of Kansas.
5	SALLY (DAY	WNING) Kansas? The Harrissons in Kansas
6	FRED	It was nothing, darling. He's just spinning tales to prevent me from finishing
7		him off.
8	SALLY	When were you going to tell me about that? Beforeor after I got married. Or
9		ever?
10	FRED	It had nothing to do with you. You didn't need to know about it.
11	SALLY	How much more have you been hiding from me?
12	FRED	Sally, please. Honey, we can put all these lies that Hartley is spinning behind
13		us.
14	SALLY	Oh, you do know him.
15	SLEEPY	What about that son? I don't think I ever mentioned who this gent is.
16	SFX	RUSTLE OF SKIRT AS SHE GETS UP AND WALKS OVER.
17	SALLY	Poor Frederick. No idea about women. You never asked about my family.
18		You never knew that Thom's family adopted me after my family was
19	SLEEPY (WI	HISPER) Hashknife! She's got her scissors in her fist
20	FRED	Oh, Sally. Give me one of your hugs to make things all right.
21	SALLY (DIS	TRAUGHT) Oh, Frederick. Please tell me this isn't happening.
22	FRED	Sally, you don't need to worry. What I did in the war is in the past. Dead and
23		gone.
24	SALLY	Did you know the Harrisons in south Kansas, like he says?
25	FRED	I don't see why I should deny it. It happened a long time ago. The war does
26		strange things to people. But, yes, I knew them.
27	HART	Particularly the sister. She thought you were gonna marry her. Right up until
28		the last second, Ah suppose.
29	FRED	Yes, she was a pretty little thing. For white trash.
30	SALLY	White trash?
31	HART	It wasn't very pretty when you left. You had your fun.

- FRED Pay no attention to him, Sally. He never liked me. I always got the girl. Just
 like I got you.
- SALLY Yes, you got me. (<u>STAB</u>) Here's one for my sister. (<u>STAB</u>) and one for my mother. (STAB) and one for my family
- 5 FRED (CONFUSED) Sally, my love. Why are you...
- 6 CHARLES You're killing him, you witch!
- 7 <u>SFX GUNFIRE</u>
- 8 FRED No, Charlie...not Sally! My pretty Sa... (DIES)
- 9 HART Get 'im Sleepy!
- 10 <u>SFX SCUFFLE</u>
- 11 SLEEPY That does it for you, Bodiddly!
- 12 <u>MUSIC CURTAIN</u>
- 13 [SCENE 6]
- 14 BOOTS ON BOARDWALK
- 15 SLEEPY (OFF) Hartley! Dog-gone it, Hashknife, hold on just a dag-napped minute!
- 16 <u>BOOTS RUNNING UP</u>
- SLEEPY (UP, PANTING) Where in tarnation do you think you're goin'? You're not to be
 walkin' on that leg!
- 19 EFX HORSE WHINNEY
- 19 <u>EFA HORSE WHINNE</u>
- 20 SFX PAT PAT PAT
- HART Ah'm goin' on mah way. Little Wolf'll handle the problems with the Res
 better'n Ah could. Besides, Ah'm not goin' to be walkin'.
- SLEEPY How're you gonna get up on that horse of yorn? You plan to swing your bad
 leg over the saddle or get up there on the wrong side? Or backwards?

HART (GRITTING HIS TEETH) Ah'll do it, never you mind. Ah don't need a nursemaid.

- 27 SLEEPY You need more than that. And I'm gonna be the one who does it.
- 28 HART Ah just cain't stay here any longer. Ah gotta ride out of here.
- 29 SLEEPY Alright, alright! Just let me go get a buckboard.
- 30 HART A buckboard? Ah can't afford that.

1	SLEEPY	I'm only borrowing it, to get you out of town. I have a dandy place where you
